Fire on the Water Returns

Celebrate Independence Day a little early in a beautiful, tranquil setting. The City of Pelham's annual fireworks show will be held Sunday, July 3rd, at Oak Mountain State Park.

Park officials invite families to spend the entire day in the park. "The gates open for the day at 7:00 a.m., so you'll have a chance to grab a good spot on the beach and enjoy all the park has to offer while you wait for the evening fireworks," said Anna Jones, Event Coordinator for Oak Mountain State Park. From 7:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., regular park entrance fees apply. From 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., the park will charge \$15 per vehicle. Discounted tickets (\$10/per vehicle) are available for Pelham residents. The park gates will close to the public at 7:00 p.m. sharp, so be sure to plan accordingly.

Flip Side Watersports will provide entertainment from 5:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. with a show that is always a crowd pleaser. "Some of the top wake boarders in the nation will be there, so it's going to be a great show," said Jones. In addition, D.J. Blaze will join the party again this year to provide some fun tunes.

Some activities to enjoy all day include beach volleyball, the Treetop Nature Trail, the playground and fishing piers. Picnic tables and grills are available in the event area on a first come, first served basis.

Parking for the event is on Terrace Drive. Be sure to bring chairs and blankets for the fireworks show. No outside alcohol is allowed.
