Support for Funding from the Railroad Crossing Elimination Grant Program

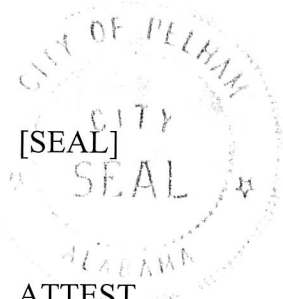
WHEREAS, the City of Pelham recognizes the need to eliminate railroad crossings within the city to promote the safety, health and well-being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Pelham City Council has determined it serves a public purpose for the City of Pelham to apply for funding from the Railroad Crossing Elimination Grant Program through the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Railroad Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pelham City Council fully supports the application by the City of Pelham for funding from the Railroad Crossing Elimination Grant Program (RCEP) through the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Railroad Administration with an 80% federal and 20% local project cost match and authorizes the Mayor on behalf of the city to draft a letter of support for the RCEP funding request.

THEREUPON David Coram, a councilmember, moved and Rick Wash, a councilmember, seconded the motion that Resolution 2022-09-19-04 be given vote, and said resolution passed by a majority vote of all members of the Council present and the Council President declared the same passed and adopted.

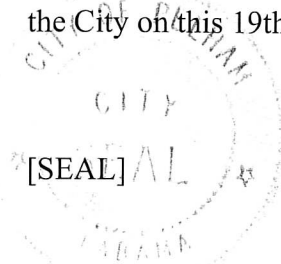
