
Some City Offices Have Moved

While some construction and landscaping are still ongoing, the long-awaited reopening of Pelham City Hall is here. Employees began moving into offices just before Christmas. The renovation allowed many departments and services to be housed under one roof.

For business licenses, you'll visit the Finance window to the left inside the main lobby. Building permits can be obtained at the Development Services window on the right. Administrative offices are also located in City Hall, which include the Mayor, City Manager, City Clerk, Communications, and Economic Development.

The ground floor is still under construction. This is where City Council chambers will be located. The projected completion date for the new space is March 2023. The public will find an inviting, state-of-the-art space for city meetings, along with a large conference room.

Pelham Water Works is still located at 3111 Cummings Street, so you can still conduct business in person in the lobby or at the convenient drive-through window. Human Resources and Information Technology (IT) are now located on the second floor of the Water Works building.

- Approved new hours for Pelham City Parks:

 - Creekside Park: Sunrise to Sunset
 - Coker Park: Sunrise to 8:00 pm
 - City Park: Sunrise to 10:00 pm
 - Fun Go Holler: Sunrise to 10:00 pm
- Site preparation to begin on the Campus No. 124 park project.
- Construction of pickleball courts at the Pelham Senior Center.
- Authorized Sain Associates to provide design services for Highway 31 lighting project.
- Funding from an AARP grant was approved to purchase and install walking path distance signage along the City Park portion of the Greenway Trail.
- Voted to add the name of Karen Bragan to the memorial obelisk at Pelham City Park.
- Extended the period of time for HES Investments, Inc. to complete their development plan for the property they have agreed to purchase near the Pelham Public Library.
- Approved various repairs for city facilities, such as the Tennis Center, Pelham Racquet Club, the Pelham Water Works building, and the Stratford Sewer Lift Station.
- Approved two 5-year contracts with Axon Enterprise, Inc. for the purchase of police equipment.
