Park 124 To Open With Community Event

The long-awaited Park 124, located behind Campus 124 along Bishop Creek, is opening with a big community party. "We're thrilled to announce the grand opening of Park 124 on Saturday, June 8, 2024," said Brian Cooper, Director of Pelham Parks and Recreation. He invites the community to join the festivities with a party in the park starting at 4:00 p.m. The event will feature live music, delicious food, and refreshing drinks.

The City of Pelham is partnering with several of the Campus 124 businesses, including The Beer Hog, Half Shell Oyster House, Valhalla Board Game Cafe, The Guy's Place, CLP System, and Wise Environmental Solutions, to create a fun community event for the entire family. Food trucks, including Hit Different Barbecue, El Compa, and Kona Ice, will be on site.

"It's the perfect opportunity for the community to come together and celebrate this beautiful new space. Bring your friends, family, and neighbors for a fun-filled evening," said Cooper. He also revealed that the event will be the first time the park is activated as part of the Pelham Entertainment District, which includes Campus 124.

Park 124 is a beautiful green space with a pavilion, picnic tables, beautiful landscaping, and walking trail. The walking trail will eventually connect with the Pelham Greenway Trail once Phase Two of the project is complete.

Development Update

Here are some updates on the new businesses, restaurants, and commercial developments you're talking about:

- Valhalla Board Game Cafe is opening soon in Campus 124. The fun new spot will offer a wide selection of tabletop games, coffee, food, and drinks in a Norse-inspired atmosphere. A post on Valhalla's Facebook page says the Cafe will host an Iron City Comic Con afterparty on June 1st.
- Poppa G's Billiards has opened in Campus 124. The new space promises a family-friendly atmosphere and will feature a kitchen for a quick bite between pool matches. We're told Poppa G's will host a tournament on June 8th.
- Jack's Family Restaurant is expected to close on the property purchase for their new Pelham location in mid-June. Construction is scheduled to begin this summer.
- HCI Pelham Central, LLC plans to close on their new property adjacent to the Pelham Public Library in mid-June. Immediately after the closing, developers will close with individual owners. Waldo's Chicken and Beer and Edgar's Bakery representatives attended the Pelham City Council Work Session on May 6th to discuss their plans.
- El Comal is one step closer to opening in the former Nino's building after the City Council approved its liquor license. Management is hiring staff and refining operations before setting a grand opening date. Stay tuned for details.
