

Library Launches New Mobile App

The Pelham Public Library is excited to introduce a new app called myLIBRO. With the app, you can have multiple library cards on your phone, keep track of account information, such as overdue fines and upcoming events, borrow items, and explore online resources.

Anyone with a library card can access myLIBRO. The app, which is funded by donations, is available for free on Apple and Android devices.

Here are the steps to sign into and access your account:

- Download the app from your app store
- Select "Shelby County Libraries (AL) – Pelham Public Library" from the list of available libraries.
- Enter your Library Card Number. If you do not have a library card, you can get one at Pelham Public Library.
- Enter your Library PIN. Everyone has a unique PIN. Your PIN is four numbers and is your birthdate: two digits for the month and two digits for the day. For example, if you were born on August 1st, it would be 0801.

Overall, myLIBRO is a great app that is accessible and easy to use. If you have questions, please get in touch with the Pelham Public Library staff. Don't wait—download the app today!



Rain Barrel Workshop

Learn how to manage stormwater runoff to save money and reduce erosion. The City of Pelham will present a Rain Barrel and Residential Gardening Workshop on Saturday, August 3rd, at 10:00 a.m. at the Pelham Public Library. Participants will learn about the problems associated with stormwater runoff, how to conserve water in their homes, and watershed-friendly landscaping techniques. The workshop will also cover the basics of constructing, installing, and maintaining a rain barrel.

The class also delves into native Alabama plants and flowers that require less maintenance and can provide year-round beauty to your yard and home. The class is free, and no registration is required.



Annual Book Sale

During the Dog Days of Summer, it's nice to have some indoor activities to escape the heat. Reading a good book or watching a thrilling movie is a wonderful way to spend a hot day in the comfort of air conditioning. The Pelham Public Library's Annual Book Sale is a great place to stock up on new and used books, movies, music, and more. The sale begins on Thursday, August 1st, and runs through Saturday, August 31st, or while supplies last.

Library Supervisor David Smith said the sale is something people look forward to each year, and it's a win-win for the library and patrons. "The proceeds from the sale go to the Library Board budget, which in turn is used to purchase new library items and materials."

Smith explained how library staffers determine the items included in the sale. "We accept donations from patrons with the knowledge that the item may go on the shelf or placed in our book sale. Either way, donations greatly benefit the library. We also weed out library items that have not circulated for years or are worn out but still usable. These all end up going to a new home through the sale."

The sale will be held in the Makerspace Room on the first floor of the Pelham Public Library.



Coaching Workshop at PRC

The Pelham Racquet Club will host a free USTA Community Coach Workshop on Wednesday, August 14th, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. This active, on-court workshop is open to players of all skill levels. Participants will learn the basic skills to coach tennis and how to run entry-level group programming.

This free training is designed for existing novice coaches and avid tennis players interested in learning to coach. It will help you make a positive impact on the lives of others while having fun on the courts.


