

# **Pelham Park & Recreation Advisory Board**

## **RESOLUTION 2013-02-18-01**

Establishing the City of Pelham Parks and Recreation Advisory Board

**WHEREAS**, the Pelham City Council desires to establish the City of Pelham Parks and Recreation Advisory Board.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Pelham City Council that the City of Pelham Parks and Recreation Advisory Board is hereby established and said Advisory Board shall operate under the following terms and conditions:

1. The Advisory Board shall consist of five (5) members selected and appointed by the municipal governing body from residents of the municipality who have a recognized interest in recreational activities.
2. The members of the Advisory Board shall be appointed as follows: One (1) for a term of one (1) year; One (1) for a term of two (2) years; One (1) for a term of three (3) years; One for a term of four (4) years; and One (1) for a term of five (5) years. All terms of office shall expire on September 30th. As the terms of members expire their successors shall be selected and appointed for terms of five (5) years. Vacancies in unexpired terms shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments and each replacement selected will be appointed to complete the term of board member that they replace.
3. Each October, the Advisory Board shall elect from its membership a chairman, vice-chairman and secretary and such other officers as it deems necessary, to serve at its pleasure.
4. The Advisory Board shall develop rules and regulations covering the procedures of the Board and rules and regulations related to the use of the applicable lands, buildings, equipment and other facilities, which shall be submitted and approved by resolution of the Pelham City Council.
5. The Advisory Board shall be responsible for the promotion of such recreation programs and contributing to the general welfare of the residents of the City of Pelham.
6. Members of the Advisory Board shall serve without compensation.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Resolution 1976-02-02-01 (Resolution #58) establishing a Pelham Recreation Board is herewith repealed in its entirety.

**ADOPTED** the 18th day of February 2013.
